
Organizer, artistic director, producer and one of the teachers at the international body music festival in Serbia "New Balkan Rhythm", founded in 2022.

She facilitates the <u>"Body as an Instrument" workshops</u> with Marko Dinjaški since 2013, workshops of body music (body percussion and singing) and various theater games. In working with different target groups, they conceptualize the ways in which they transfer knowledge.

She is one of the performers and authors of the album "Rika Taka, New Balkan Rhythm", which combines the cultural heritage of the Balkan countries with innovative musical arrangements and body music technique. The album was released by a German label CPL Music in the end of 2022 and was highly ranked in World Music Charts Europe and Balkan World Music Charts. The concert was performed in the Balkan region and EU (Germany, Slovakia, Bulgaria, Hungary, Croatia, Slovenia, Albania etc).

In 2020 and 2021, she has been participating in the children's play "The Cricket and the Ant on a Birthday" as a musical and theater performer, author of stage movement and music composer.

One of the authors and performers of the music for the **musical series for children** on regional TV Vojvodina network <u>"Centipede Rhymes"</u>. Preforms the musical theater show of same title for children in the region.

She composed the music for **the children's TV show "Uprirodise"** produced by "Zanatsko Filmska Zadruga", which is broadcasted on the program of national television of Serbia, RTS.

She composed and performed, with Marko Dinjaški, the award-winning radio piece "Into the Forest" produced by Radio Belgrade and directed by Marija Krstić.

One of the authors and producers of the accredited seminar for teachers "Rhymes and body music as a means of work in the development of speech in preschool children". She presents the body music as a tool for development of speech and movement in children in seminares, conferences and workshops.
